On February 16, 1955, this powerful, rambunctious personality was so large he required an escort, a twin to temporarily harness his dynamism as the third son born to the union of James Edward, Sr. and Callie Cook Gandy. Born in the small southern town of Evergreen, Alabama due to a brief visit by his mother, it quickly became obvious he was far too much for any little town as he began to come of age. As the eldest twin Claude earned the distinction of big brother to his twin sister and little brother to his two older brothers. After birth Claude was taken home to Baltimore, Maryland, and the family ultimately moved to New Brunswick, New Jersey where Claude would receive his education through the public school system. Time, experiences and communications would lend him several nicknames, including Ham and Mr. G.

Claude was preceded in death by his father who he idolized til death, Bishop James E. Gandy, Sr., his brothers, Dempsey Gandy and Bishop Jerome Gandy, and his nephew, Titus Gandy. He leaves to mourn and
