The family moved from Virginia to Philadelphia, Pennsylvania in 1943 where she began her education. The family then relocated from Philadelphia to Pleasantville/Egg Harbor Township where she continued and completed her education. Mother Camper was a very loving and caring person. She worked as a Teacher's Assistant at South Main Elementary School until she retired.

Mother Camper met and married the late Andrew Camper and from that union they were blessed with one son, who was the apple of her eye, the late Minister Darhyl Anthony Camper, Sr.

In 1954, Mother Camper was introduced to the Lord by the late Mother Drake and the late Mother Hopkins of the Morning Star Holiness Church Assembly. Mother Camper decided to make Jesus her choice, she was baptized in the Name of Jesus, and was filled with the Holy Ghost, therefore becoming a member into the family of God. After 50 plus years of faithfulness she was elevated to the title of Church Mother, which she was very proud of. Mother Camper loved the people of God and was loved in return by the Morning Star Assembly of Jesus Only family and those which she fellowshiped with. Mother Camper enjoyed spending alone time in the sanctuary just her and her Jesus. Mother Camper had one of the most beautiful singing voices. She loved singing hymns and spiritual songs. She used this special gift to bring glory to God and to bless his people. Mother Camper was one of the original pioneers of the 6am prayer line. It was her heart's desire to see her grandchildren saved and working and serving in whatever capacity the Lord would call them.

Mother Camper was feisty and would stand firmly and tell you what saith the Lord, whether you wanted to hear it or not. Many times we would hear Mother Camper encouraging the people of God to "cry loud and spare not, "DON'T COMPROMISE, and preach the word". She was a woman of great strength and determination. Mother camper would tell you "It's holiness or hell, there's no in between". Mother Camper would often say "I LOVE my little family, I want them saved". Mother Camper leaves a legacy of prayer and faithfulness. She was a glowing example of what she believed a Godly woman should be according to the scriptures.
