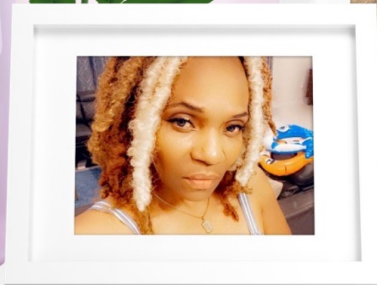
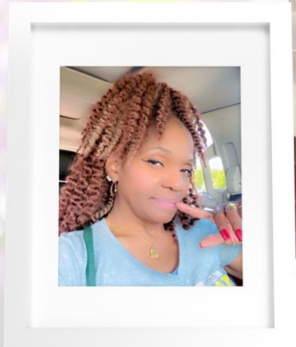

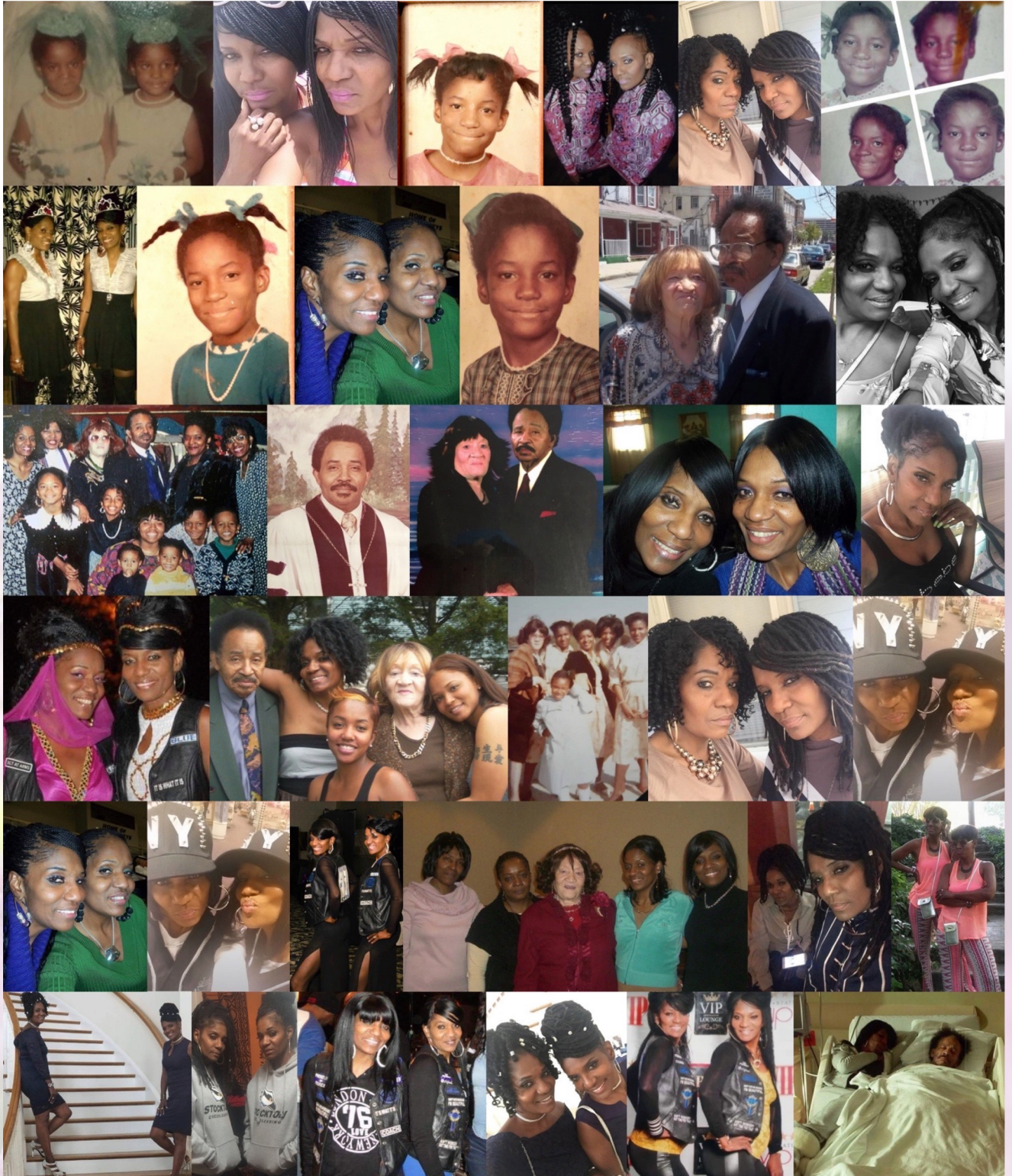




Sonia Trapp was born to Reverend Clifford and Marvin Trapp in Atlantic City, NJ.

 Richly blessed is how I feel having a grandmother just like you*

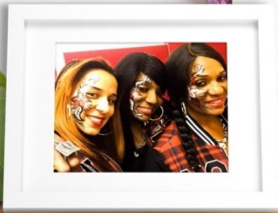
